This Council needs to start taking control of things.

That budget promo video was an insult to you and to us.

It was a perfect example of how the city manager basically tells council what to do and you do it.

You listened spellbound to that video, a one sided sales pitch designed to eliminate questions, all the while nodding and smiling.

"Look," they said, we've arranged everything. You just need to sign on the dotted line.

We deserve a council who knows that its job is to reign in the city staff and not go along with every slick ad campaign.

Have you thought about saying, "Come back to us with a budget that doesn't exceed the NNR rate?"

I know at least a couple of you are not comfortable with the budget. Why are you not speaking up?

City property tax increases require a two-thirds vote.

You only need three members to block an increase and default to the NNR rate.
